Kindergarten Student Options:

Girls: Black twill skort with red short sleeve monogrammed polo knit shirt.
Sneakers may be worn with the skort with white or black ankle socks.

Jumper with short sleeve white Peter Pan Collar blouse.
Black dress shoes with white or black ankle socks (no “no show” socks).

NO COLORED SOCKS or BASKETBALL SOCKS

Boys: Black walking shorts or uniform pants belted.
Red short sleeve monogrammed polo knit shirt.
Sneakers with black or white above the ankle socks (no “no” show socks)

NO COLORED SOCKS or BASKETBALL SOCKS

Grades 1 – 6 Options:

Girls: Black twill skort with red polo short sleeve monogrammed polo knit shirt.
Low rise sneakers may be worn with this uniform.
Black or white only above the ankle socks (no “no” show socks).

Plaid skirt with white button down blouse.
Black dress shoes with white or black ankle socks (no “no show” socks).

NO COLORED SOCKS OR BASKETBALL SOCKS

Boys: Black walking shorts or uniform pants belted.
Red short sleeve monogrammed polo knit shirt.
Sneakers with black or white above the ankle socks (no “no” show socks).
