**Uniforms** - As of Monday, Nov. 3rd, the Summer Uniform ends. Please follow the Fall/Winter Uniform Policy.

- Boys K-8 Boys can no longer wear shorts with sneakers. They must wear black twill pants with a belt and dress shoes.
- Girls K-8 Girls can no longer wear the skort with sneakers. Girls in Grades K-3 must wear the school plaid jumper, blouse, and dress shoes. Girls in Grades 4-8 must wear the school plaid skirt, Oxford style blouse, and dress shoes. They can also wear black twill pants with a school polo and dress shoes.
- \*All students may wear their school gym sweatshirt, school fleeces or the school crested sweaters over the regular school uniform.
